

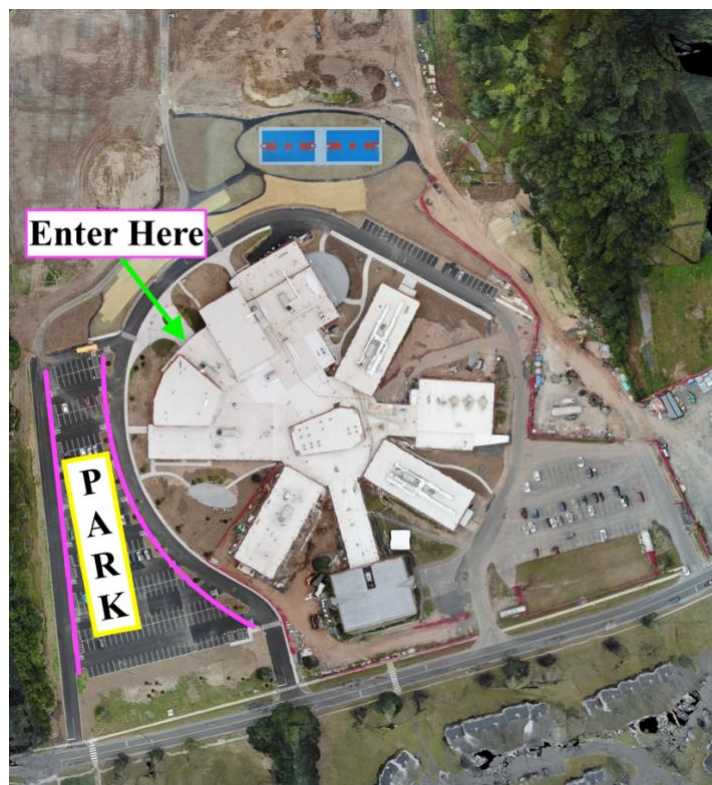
Greetings JFK School Community,
