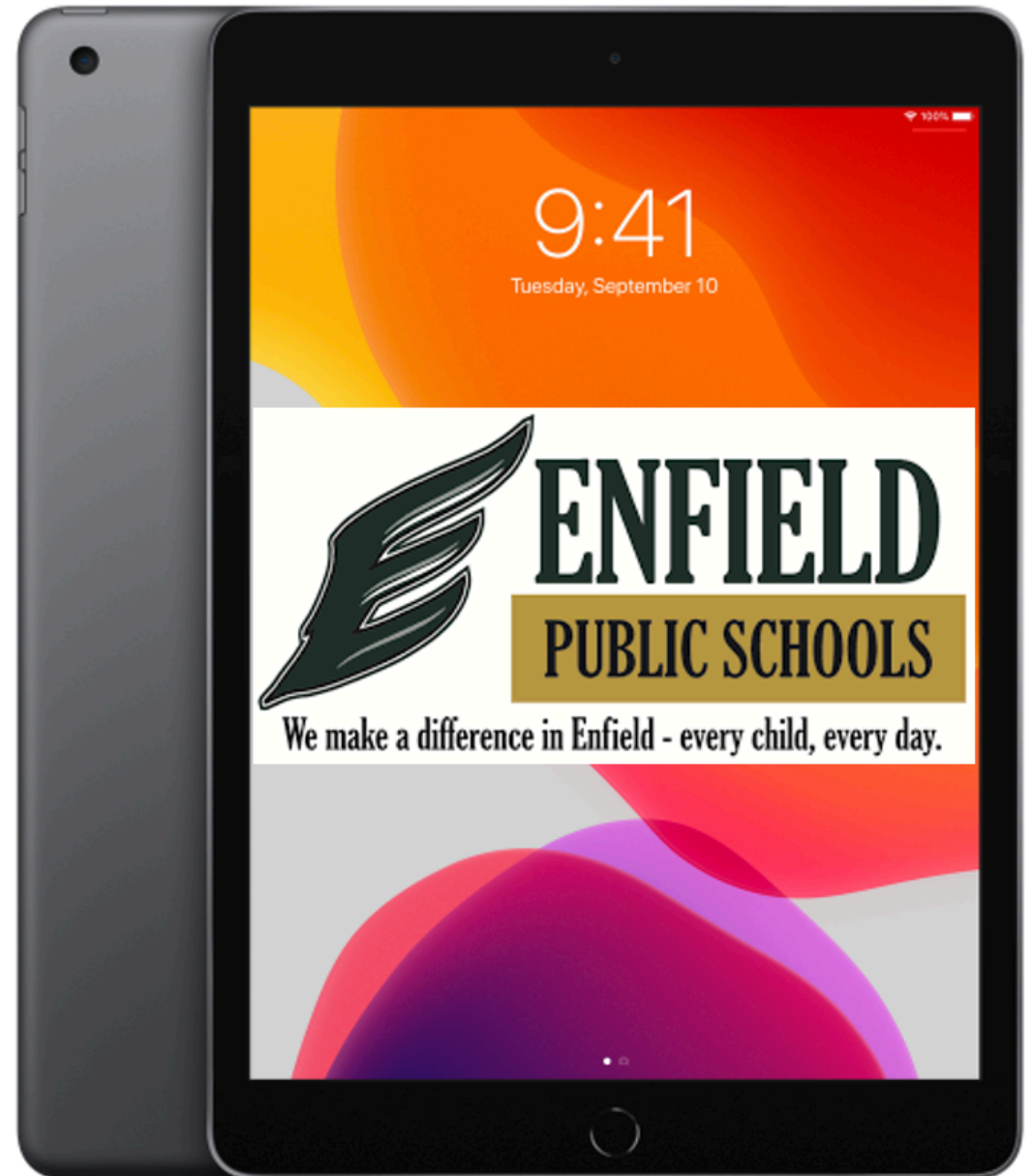

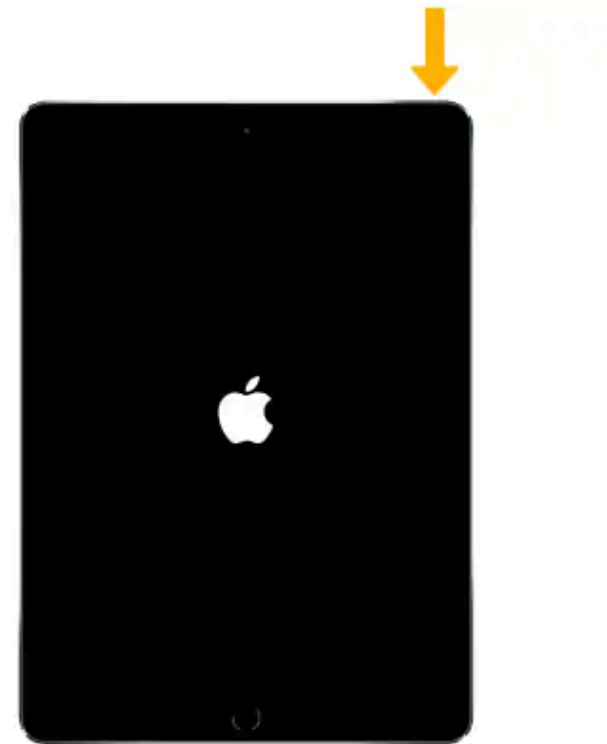
GETTING TO KNOW YOUR DEVICE



POWER ON

Turn on device

Press and hold the **Sleep/Wake button** until the Apple logo displays.

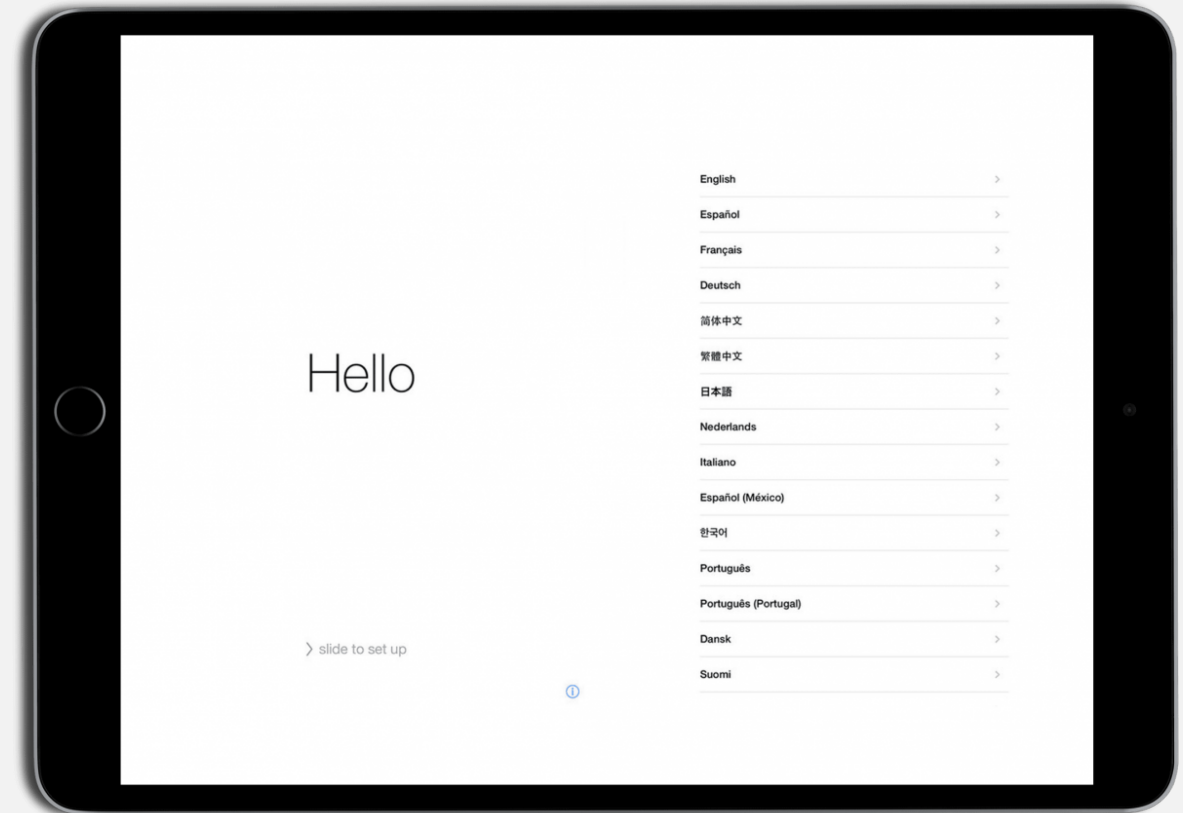


SETTINGS

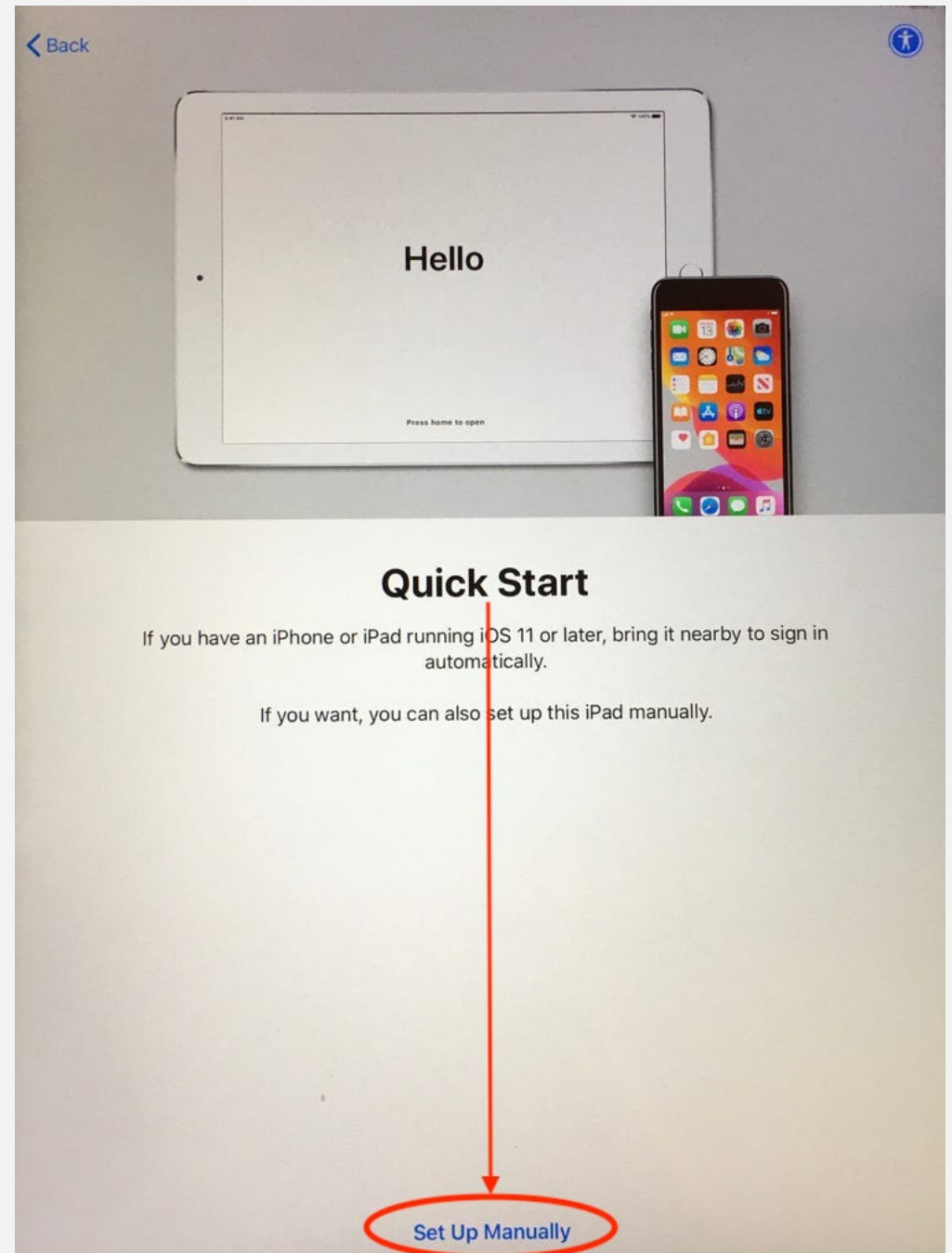
Apple utilizes a very intuitive setup process. Users will be prompted to fill in their user information. Please ensure you select the applicable settings:

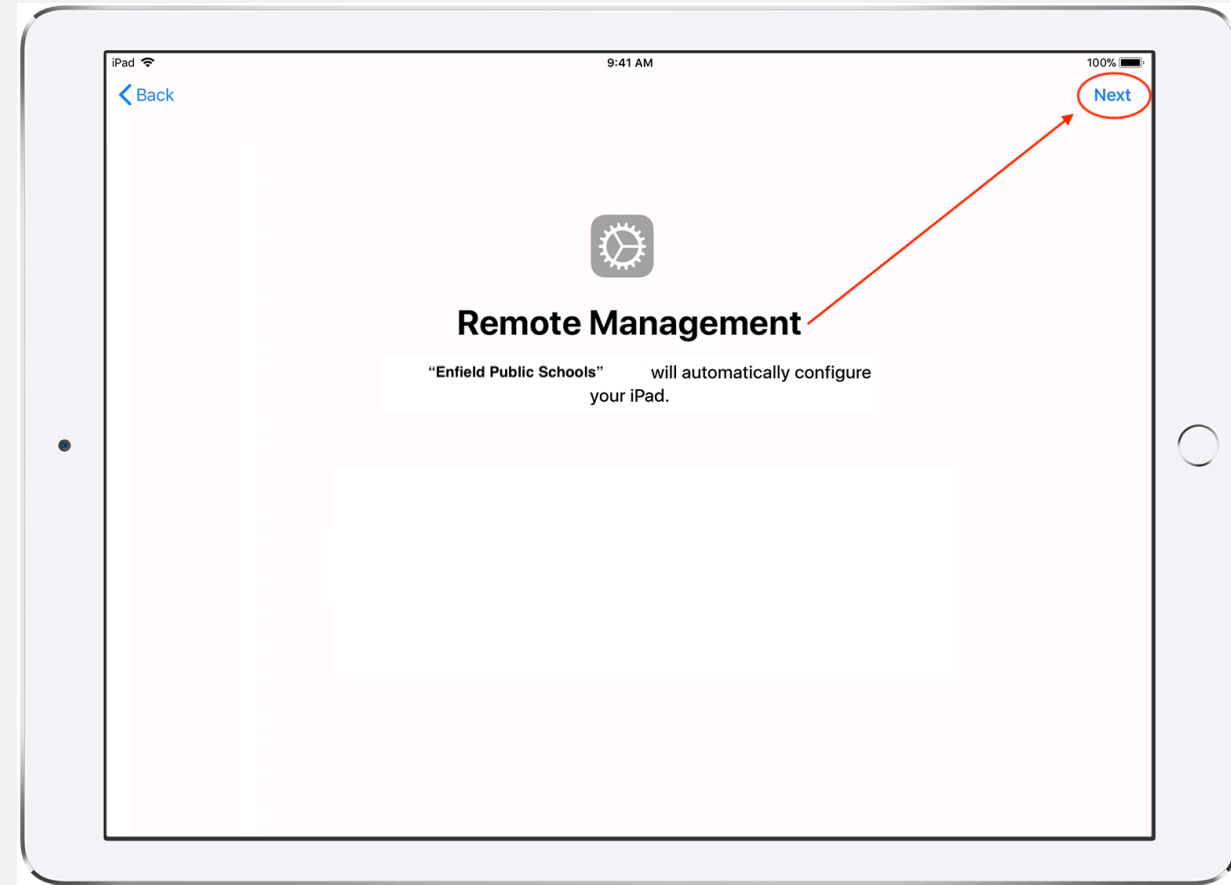

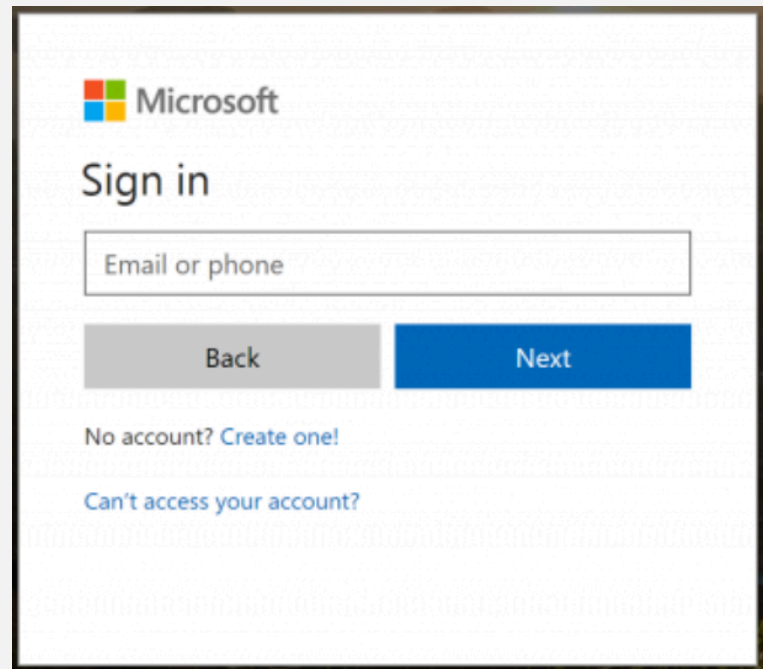
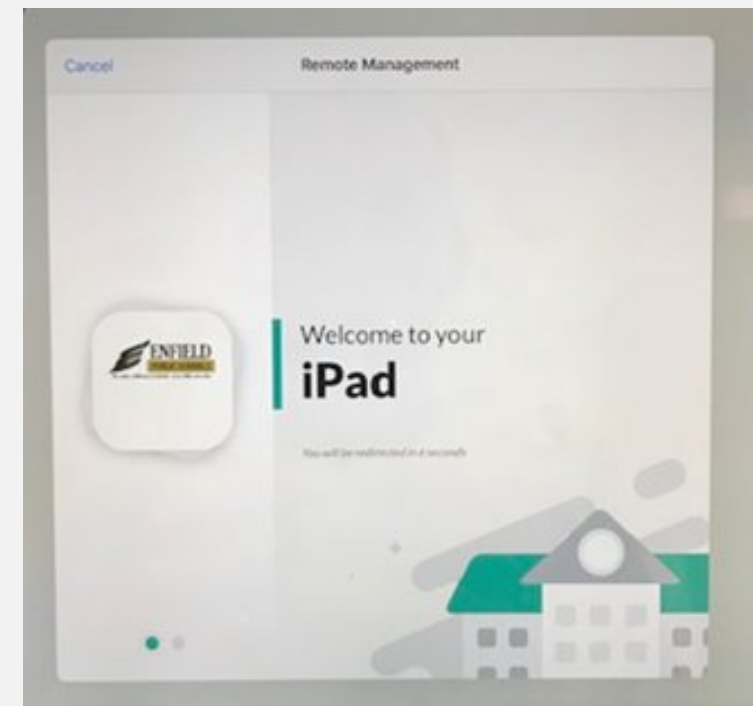
REMOTE MANAGEMENT

Your iPad will communicate that it is “retrieving configuration.” Once complete, your iPad will display the “remote management” screen. Please select “Next.”



REMOTE MANAGEMENT

The iPad will display EPS's welcome screen and prompt the user to enter their school-issued Microsoft 365 account login information. Once your information is entered, click "Next."

CREATE YOUR IPAD PASSCODE

Select “passcode options” and create your 4 or 6 digit code. Once entered, click “Next” and you will be prompted to verify your passcode. After re-entering your code, click “Next” again.

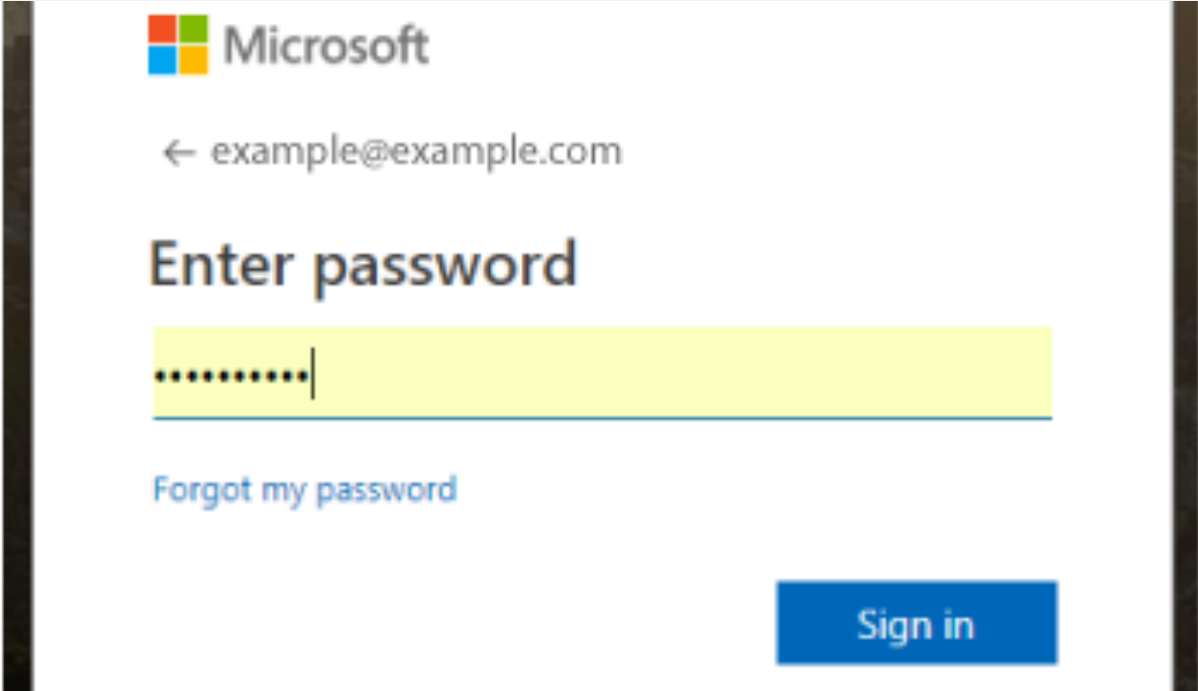

Drag an icon to the far right to create additional Home screens.

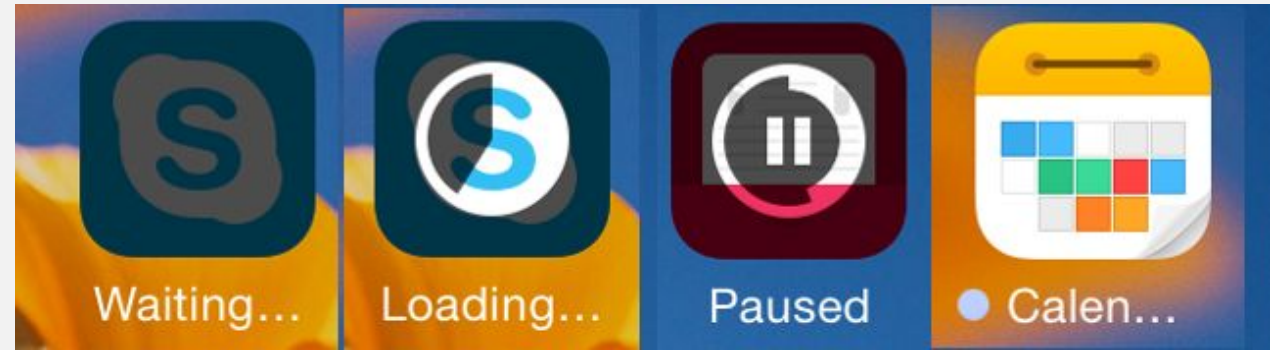

complete before moving to the next step.

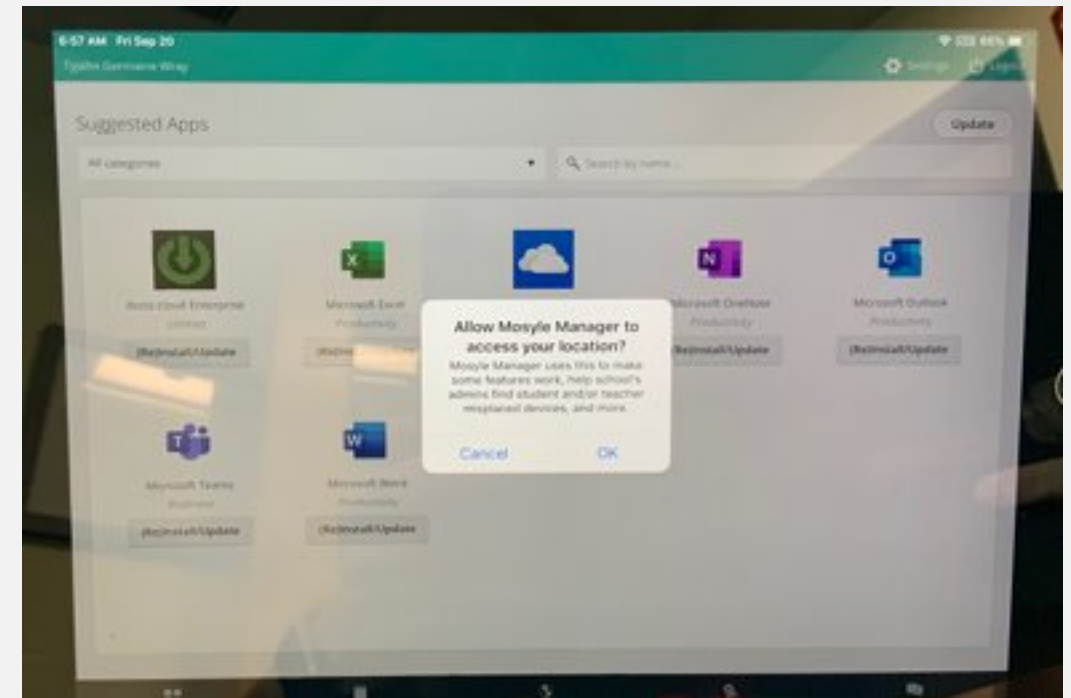
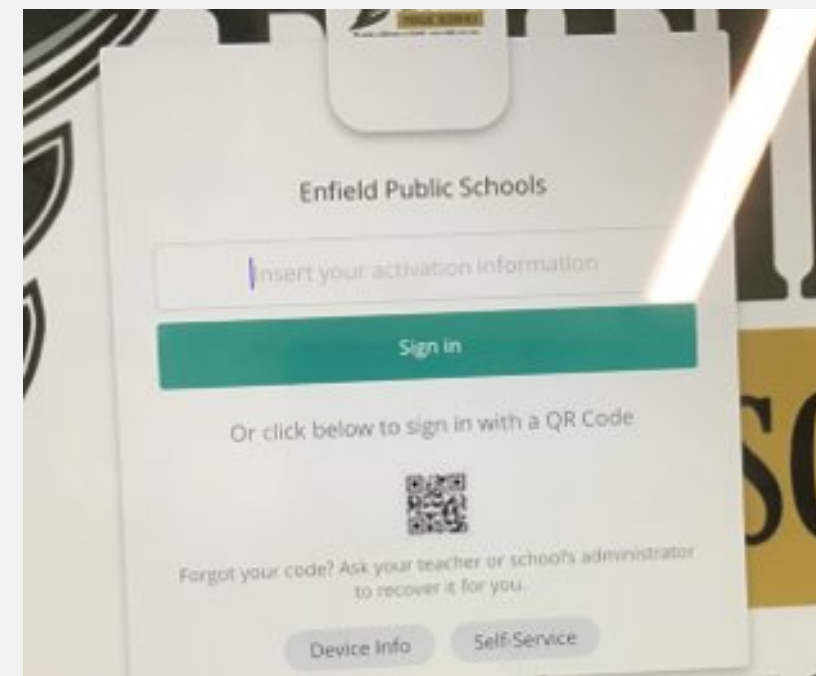
Select the Mosyle Manager Application.



MOSYLE MANAGER

The Mosyle App will prompt the user to submit their “activation information.” Please input your school-issued MS 365 email address.

You will receive an alert from Mosyle Manager to access your location, select “Ok.”



APP MANAGEMENT

Your APPs will be managed by Mosyle. If your school-related apps do not appear in this window, select “Update” located in the upper right corner.

It is imperative that you open and login to your Microsoft Applications with your school-issued credentials.

KEEP YOUR IPAD UPDATED

To ensure all apps are working and platforms are integrating correctly, please keep your Apple operating software up-to-date.



SAFEGUARDS

- Take a picture of your iPad serial number and Asset tag number store them on another device.
- Keep the iPad away from extreme hot/cold temperatures.
- Keep liquids away from the iPad
- Do not place heavy objects on the iPad.
- Do not lend the iPad to anyone.
- Keep the iPad off of the ground/floor.
- Keep your iPad in its protective case.
- Do not share your passcode or passwords with anyone.

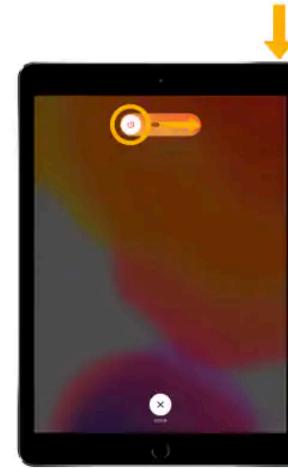

POWERING OFF AND UNLOCKING


Turn off device

Press and hold the **Sleep/Wake button** until the slider appears. Drag the **slider** to turn your iPad completely off.



Unlock device

Press the **Sleep/Wake** or **Home button**, then press the **Home button** again to unlock your device.

Note: iPad locks automatically if your device is idle for 2 minutes. To adjust the screen lock time, select the  > Settings app > Display & Brightness > Auto-Lock > desired lock time.
